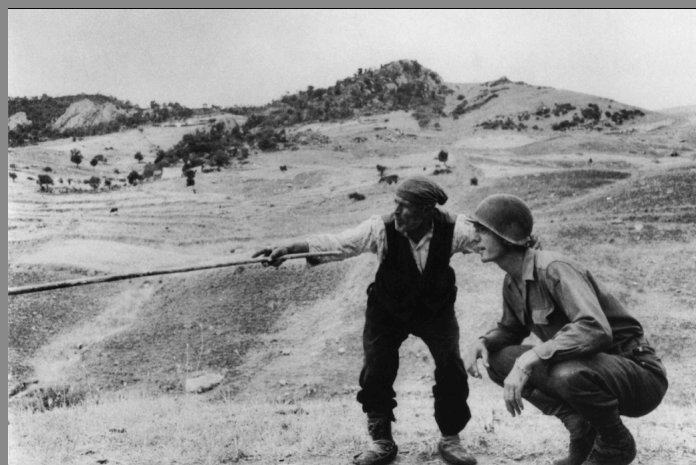


Tommaso continues to be busy performing his projects as a band leader and contributing as a side man across Jazz Clubs and Festivals around the world, some of these include:
